

**CITY OF SHEBOYGAN
RESOLUTION 79-23-24**

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Chief of Police to take necessary actions to receive the 2024 Wisconsin Justice System Improvement Beat Patrol Grant.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan Police Department has the opportunity to obtain a Beat Patrol Grant in the amount of \$121,434 from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the Beat Patrol Grant program provides funds to support additional police personnel for community work and Beat Patrols for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the grant in the amount of \$121,434, the Chief of Police is required to submit an application through the Wisconsin Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the funding received would be \$121,434 from the State of Wisconsin with a local match of \$40,478 (25%) required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan Police Department is eligible for funding for calendar year 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan Common Council authorizes the Chief of Police to sign all documents necessary to obtain and administer the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan has provided in its proposed 2024 budget an appropriation for a matching allocation for the project and is committed to ensuring said allocation remains in the budget as approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That it is the sense of the Common Council that it would be appropriate for future Councils to make such annual appropriations as long as state matching aids are available or until this resolution is modified by the Council, subject to the right of future Councils to make necessary modifications as may be required by changes to the program or the financial needs of the City.
