We, hereby, submit the Board of Water Commissioners' Report on the Water Utility for the fourth quarter of 2025.

The water pumpage decreased 2.94% from the same period in 2024. 991,147,000 gallons were pumped in the fourth quarter 2025, compared to 1,021,123,000 in 2024.

The 2025 audited balance sheet and income statement will be submitted separately in April 2026 upon completion of the final audit.
