A RESOLUTION authorizing the appropriate City officials to accept and expend funds received from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources as part of the Urban Forestry Inflation Reduction Act (UFIRA) Grant Program.

WHEREAS, suspension of Council rules to allow for immediate passage is appropriate in order to timely accept grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan Public Works Department has obtained an UFIRA grant in the amount of \$174,616 from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources to support the reforestation and retention of trees to improve air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resource UFIRA Program provides funds to increase the tree canopy within the City's disadvantaged areas by planting new street trees and retaining mature ash trees with continued insecticide treatments for the period September 3, 2024 through December 31, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary for the acceptance, administration, and expenditure of the grant described in this Resolution.
