BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS: Due to the reconstruction of Indiana this summer/fall of 2022, South 24th Street between Indiana Avenue and Georgia Avenue was temporarily changed from a one-way street to a two-way street so that the residents on South 24th Street had better access to their residences during the reconstruction of Indiana Avenue. With the reconstruction of Indiana Avenue now completed this section of South 24th Street will be reinstated to a one-way street with on-street parking on the west side of South 24th Street.

STAFF COMMENTS: Since the reconstruction of Indiana Avenue is completed, City staff supports changing this section of South 24th Street back to one-way street with parking on the west side of South 24th Street.
