SUBJECT: Resolution 54-26-27 – A Resolution authorizing the appropriate City Officials to expend General Funds to purchase one (1) 2027 Tymco 600 Street Sweeper.

ISSUE

Should the Public Works Committee recommend approval of the Resolution to purchase one Tymco 600 Street Sweeper to replace one existing Swartz Street Sweeper (2010) currently in use by the Department of Public Works.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the resolution utilizing 2026 budgeted funds within the Motor Vehicle account.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

The purchase of one Tymco 600 Street Sweeper will replace one older unit which is a 16-year-old unit currently in use by the Department. The Department of Public Works operates three sweepers daily when manpower allows. Maintaining a quality street sweeping program is vital to the City for many reasons, such as providing a clean general appearance, removing debris and grit from the streets, minimizing issues with plugged storm sewers, and aids in vehicle accident cleanup efforts.

Not only is street sweeping necessary for maintaining a quality of life standard, but a robust street sweeping program allows the City to meet its storm water quality expectations set forth by its MS4 Storm Water Permit issued through the Department of Natural Resources. (phosphorous removal)

The proposed new unit will be replacing one current unit that is a 2010 model unit. While the existing unit still functions, at 16 years old, the unit has significant wear. Timely replacement of the unit is necessary to avoid extensive maintenance costs in the future.

Staff worked with several local vendors requesting Sourcewell Contract Quotes for comparable units. The quoted costs include the trade-in value of the Department's current 2010 Schwartz sweeper.
