

**CITY OF SHEBOYGAN
ORDINANCE 16-26-27**

AN ORDINANCE amending article 52-III of the Sheboygan Municipal Code so as to update the annual flat city registration fee.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENT “Article 52-III Motor Vehicles Registration Fees” of the Sheboygan Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec 52-78 Imposition

- (a) Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 341.35, an annual flat city registration fee of ~~\$20.00~~ **\$30.00** is hereby imposed on all motor vehicles registered in the state which are customarily kept in the city. The city registration fee shall be in addition to state registration fees.
- (b) In this section, the term "motor vehicle" means an automobile or motor truck registered under Wis. Stats. § 341.25(1)(c), at a gross weight of not more than 8,000 pounds.

Sec 52-79 Exemptions

The following vehicles are exempt from the city vehicle registration fee:

- (a) All vehicles exempted by Wis. Stats. ch. 341, from payment of a state vehicle registration fee.
- (b) All vehicles registered by the state under Wis. Stats. § 341.26 for a fee of \$5.00.

Sec 52-80 Replacement Vehicles

The city vehicle registration fee may not be imposed on a motor vehicle which is a replacement for a motor vehicle for which a current city vehicle registration fee has been paid.

Sec 52-81 Payment

- (a) The city registration fee shall be paid, as provided in Wis. Stats. § 341.35(5).
- (b) All monies remitted to the city by the state department of transportation pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 341.35, shall be directed for use by the city for the operation and maintenance of the streets within the city.
- (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-868, no transfer shall be made of any portion of the funds raised from the city registration fee to any other purpose, fund, or object.

Sec 52-82 Administration

The city finance director/treasurer shall be responsible for the administration of this article.

SECTION 2: **REPEALER CLAUSE** All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: **EFFECTIVE DATE** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
