CITY OF SHEBOYGAN ORDINANCE 10-23-24

BY ALDERPERSONS MITCHELL AND FILICKY-PENESKI.

JULY 3, 2023.

AN ORDINANCE amending section 2-840 so as to authorize the Finance Director/ Treasurer to establish petty cash funds in various departments and to set limits for such funds .

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: <u>AMENDMENT</u> "Sec 2-840 Petty Cash Funds" of the Sheboygan Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

Sec 2-840 Petty Cash Funds

- (a) PThe finance director/treasurer may establish petty cash funds within city departments for small or emergency expenditures. The maximum value of such funds shall be determined by the finance director/treasurer based on the needs of the department. shall be established in the following departments in the indicated amounts:

 Library board: \$434.00. Building inspection: \$150.00. Fire department: \$50.00. Police department: \$525.00. Municipal court: \$100.00. Sheboygan Transit: \$500.00. City elerk: \$100.00.
- (b) The Petty amount of the finance director/treasurer's petty cash funds shall not be utilized for \$2,500.00, and no salary or, wage advances or for loans shall be made from this account.
