

**CITY OF SHEBOYGAN
RESOLUTION 25-26-27**

A PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION declaring intent to exercise the police power to levy special assessments for installation of new water main and/or laterals in Julson Court from Wildwood Avenue to approximately 615 feet east.

WHEREAS, the water main serving the area between Taylor Drive, South 22nd Street, New Jersey Avenue, and the Sheboygan River is not currently served by a continuous loop water main; and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan Water Utility has determined that installing a water main in Julson Court from Wildwood Avenue to approximately 615 feet east will result in a continuous loop water main thereby increasing water pressure to and benefiting the properties served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan intends to exercise its municipal police powers under § 66.0703, Stats., for the municipal purpose stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Water Utility is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a report in accordance with § 66.0703(4) and § 66.0703(5), Stats., and that such report shall contain the following information:

- a. Preliminary or final plans and specifications
- b. An estimate of the entire cost of the proposed work or improvement
- c. A schedule of the proposed assessments
- d. A statement that the work or improvement constitutes an exercise of the municipality's police power
- e. A statement that the property against which the assessments are proposed are benefitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the expenses so incurred in excess of \$100.00 may be paid in five (5) annual installments—or ten (10) annual installments if the expense exceeds \$5,000.00 for a single parcel of property—under § 66.0703, Stats., with interest thereon at seven percent (7%) commencing the first of the month following the completion of thirty (30) days after publication of the installment assessment notice.
