2-8-1: PURPOSE AND FUNCTION:

It shall be the purpose and function of the Parking Commission of the city of Sidney to formulate and propose rules and regulations to govern parking of all vehicles in the city of Sidney; and to formulate and propose plans for the acquisition and utilization of parking areas for the city of Sidney. (Ord. 276, 4-3-1978; amd. Ord. 586, 1-4-2021)

2-8-2: APPOINTMENT:

The parking commission shall consist of the City Chief of Police, the City Director of Public Works and the City Fire Marshall, as well as three (3) residents of the city of Sidney who will be nominated by the Mayor and approved by the City Commission. (Ord. 276, 4-3-1978; amd. Ord. 586, 1-4-2021)

2-8-3: TERM:

Appointments of residents of the City of Sidney shall be for a term of three (3) years. The Chief of Police, Director of Public Works and City Fire Marshal shall serve for so long as they are employed in the named position. (Ord. 276, 4-3-1978; amd. Ord. 586, 1-4-2021)

2-8-4: QUALIFICATIONS:

All persons who would qualify to hold a municipal office under the conditions of the laws of the state of Montana shall be qualified to serve on the parking commission. (Ord. 276, 4-3-1978; amd. Ord. 586, 1-4-2021)
