

SIDNEY PUBLIC POOL BULKHEAD OPTIONS






PERMANENT CONCRETE BULKHEAD AND RAISE FLOOR

- Cost \$350,000 (includes painting pool)
- Pros
 - Increased functionality of pool
 - Decrease volume of water by approximately 9%
 - Increase efficiency of water filter and heater
 - Possible reduction of pump motor size
 - Reduced treatment chemicals
 - Reduced utility costs
- Cons
 - Cost
 - Likely not feasible for this year



MODULAR ALUMINUM BULKHEAD

- Cost \$100,000+
- Pros
 - Crane not necessary for installing in pool
- Cons
 - Storage
 - Tripping hazard if anchored to top deck
 - May need 2+ anchors (concrete buckets) per platform (8 platforms)



ANCHOR MODULAR BULKHEAD AND RAISE FLOOR

- Cost \$300,000
- Pros
 - · Increased functionality of pool
 - Decrease volume of water by approximately 9%
 - Increase efficiency of water filter and heater
 - · Possible reduction of pump motor size
 - Reduced treatment chemicals
 - Reduced utility costs
 - Bulkhead can be installed this for this season and raising the floor can be done before next season
- Cons
 - Cost
