A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE RICHLAND COUNTY MULTI- HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the mission of the **City of Sidney** and the participating jurisdictions are charged to protect the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of the City; and

WHEREAS, Sidney, Montana is subject to flooding, severe summer storms, drought, wildfire, tornadoes, winter storms, and other natural, technological, and human hazards; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and postdisaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, the City has participated in and completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Sidney:

- 1.) Adopts in its entirety the 2022 Richland County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (Plan).
- 2.) Will use the adopted and approved portions of the Plan to guide pre- and post-disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- 3.) Will coordinate the strategies identified in the Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.
- 4.) Will continue its support of the Planning Committee and continue to participate in the planning partnership as described by the Plan.
- 5.) Will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all planning partners.
