
Public joins search for Katelynn Berry

ON JANUARY 28, 2022, THE SIDNEY POLICE DEPARTMENT INITIATED A HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION AFTER OFFICERS RESPONDING TO A WELFARE CHECK LOCATED CHRISTOPHER WETZSTEIN DECEASED IN HIS SIDNEY APARTMENT FROM A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE HEAD. MONTANA DCI WAS CALLED IN TO ASSIST IN THIS INVESTIGATION.

K9 Ringo and his handler, Officer Tanner Gomke completed a 6-week training program at Shallow Creek Kennels in Sharpsville, Pennsylvania, and hit the road for the Sidney PD on January 30th. The purchase price of the dog and the training costs were covered through two grants the SPD received totaling \$22,000.

Since K9 Ringo and Officer Gomke have hit the streets they have had four successful deployments during which they have recovered methamphetamine, a handgun, and a wanted felon. He has already been a great addition to the Sidney Police Department.

LYNDSEE COLETTE BREWER, 51, OF FORSYTH, MONTANA WAS CHARGED WITH THE MURDER OF CHRISTOPHER A. WETZSTEIN. BREWER WAS ARRESTED ON TUESDAY, APRIL 26, 2022 IN MILES CITY, MONTANA AND CHARGED WITH ONE COUNT OF DELIBERATE HOMICIDE.

An arrest warrant was issued on Feb. 22, 2022 but officers were not able to execute the warrant until April 26, 2022 due to the fact Brewer had been admitted to a hospital for life-threatening conditions and remained in a hospital until the day she was arrested.



Funded by the U.S. Department of Justice, COPS Office the Crime Scene Management – Field Techniques course is designed to teach basic crime scene investigation techniques. This hands-on training program offers sworn and non-sworn crime scene investigators and technicians access to forensic evidence identification, doc-umentation, collection, and preservation procedures.

During the 40-hour block of instruction participants receive hands-on training in the areas of DNA evidence, fingerprinting, bloodstain pattern analysis, photography, evidence collection and packaging, documentation, crime scene sketching and more. The introductory level course blends facilitated learning and lecture periods with mock crime scenes and provides a safe and effective training environment for crime scene personnel.

The Sidney Police Department is investigating the whereabouts of 4-year-old Taylem Berry. Taylem is the son of Raymond Berry and Autumn Jorstad, and is believed to be in the custody of his father. Raymond has not communicated with Autumn since October 9th, 2022 regarding his or Taylem's whereabouts.

It is known that on or about October 9, 2022, Raymond Berry quit his job and moved out of his Sidney, Montana apartment. It also appears that Berry made preparations for a long-term absence.

Berry is believed to have taken Taylem and left the State of Montana, and is believed to be in the Colorado area, but may be traveling to Washington, as Berry has family in both Washington and Colorado.

Raymond (Ray) Berry is a 39-year-old male, 5'9" tall, weighs about 200 pounds with a stocky build. Raymond normally has long curry brown hair and a goatee but may have cut his hair and shaved his facial hair to disguise his identity.

Taylem is a 4-year-old male, 42" tall, weighs about 38 pounds with a wiry build. Taylem normally has long blond curly hair but it may be cut or dyed to disguise his identity. Taylem may be going by the name of Ragnor AllFather Berry.

Raymond and Taylem are believed to be traveling in a 1995 dark green Ford F-350 pickup bearing MT license F0016. The pickup may have a matching topper and may be pulling a silver or gray Haulmark enclosed trailer bearing MT license BSY618.
