Open Container Law

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANDPOINT, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING SANDPOINT CITY CODE TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 9, OPEN CONTAINER LAW; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Following is a summary of the provisions of Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_.

Ordinance Section 1 amends City Code 3-2-9, Open Container Law, to allow for the consumption of alcoholic beverages under certain conditions during special events at Farmin Park, War Memorial Field, within the buildings located at 607 and 611 South Ella Avenue in Lakeview Park, and the James E. Russell Sports Center at Travers Park.

Ordinance Section 2 provides for repeal and severability.

Ordinance Section 3 provides for publication and an effective date.
