### **DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:**



#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

At the April 17<sup>th</sup> 2024 City Council meeting, the updated Sandpoint Urban Area Transportation Plan was adopted by council. The primary purpose of the UATP is to identify projects in the Sandpoint Urban Area (Sandpoint, Dover, Kootenai, Ponderay, and Bonner County) for only one specific type of funding, "Surface Transportation Program Urban Funds." The different jurisdictions come together at a meeting before each funding cycle and agree on a single project to submit for funding as an urban area.

Shortly after adoption, the Bonner County Area Transportation Team convened to refine and adjust (e.g. "smooth") the urban area boundaries based on population data from the 2020 census, as is required when a new plan is adopted.

The results of the collaborative effort of Urban Area Boundary "smoothing" are below.



**ACTION:** Staff asks City Council to approve a resolution accepting the smoothed Sandpoint Urban Area Boundaries.
