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Hi Hayley,

Here are the pesticide details as requested in the lease. Please let me know if there are any other details needed. I'll do my best to get them answered efficiently. I've also included information on our external communication efforts.

Application Dates: **July 25, July 29, July 31, August 4, and August 7.**

Note on application dates: These are maximum application dates. Depending on weather, and pest presence, we may not use all dates as requested.

Proposed Pesticide Trade Name: Bifen I/T

Target Pest: Spiders, Ants, Stink Bugs, Bees, Mosquitos – Really any general bug in our area

Application Plan: Power spray the areas of concern in/around the festival area. Spray the exterior of the food vendor booths BEFORE they are occupied. Do a mosquito fog spray the day before the first event (same chemical, just a fogging technique of spraying which is more effective for flying insects) and another spray/fogging application on one of the off days between the festival.

Product label instructions and precautions related to public safety:

Hazard Statement(s): Harmful if inhaled. May cause an allergic skin reaction.

Precautionary Statement(s):

Prevention: Avoid breathing mist/ vapors/spray. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Contaminated work clothing must not be allowed out of the workplace. Wear protective gloves.

Response: IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call a poison center/doctor if you feel unwell. IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. IF SKIN IRRITATION OR RASH OCCURS: Get medical advice/attention. Specific treatment (see first aid section of this document). Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Storage: No statement required.

Disposal: Dispose of contents/container in accordance with Federal, state and local laws and regulations.

Clear communication on not applying on all dates, but having the option to apply pesticide on dates approved, weather permitting.

We do not apply in windy conditions: breeze above 10mph or with rain in the forecast within 24 hours.
