RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF SANDPOINT

TITLE: APPROVING THE ARTS, CULTURE, AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION'S ARTIST SELECTION FOR THE SUMMER STREET BANNER ART PROGRAM

WHEREAS: The City of Sandpoint issued a call for public art for the Summer Street Banner Art Program through the Arts, Culture, and Historic Preservation Commission;

WHEREAS: The purpose of the project is to enhance public spaces through visually engaging artwork that contributes to Sandpoint's civic identity, supports community placemaking, and reflects the character of Sandpoint as a lake, mountain, recreation, and arts community;

WHEREAS: The City received nine proposals for the Summer Street Banner Art Program;

WHEREAS: The Arts, Culture, and Historic Preservation Commission reviewed and scored the submitted proposals and identified the highest-scoring submission through its evaluation process;

WHEREAS: The Commission selected artist Katie Winkler and her proposed artwork, "Endless Adventure," for recommendation to the City Council;

WHEREAS: The proposed artwork features a colorful composition highlighting biking, hiking, sailing, and shopping, with Lake Pend Oreille serving as a unifying visual element that celebrates outdoor recreation, downtown activity, local commerce, and the summer experience in Sandpoint; and

WHEREAS: The fiscal impact of the project is limited to the budget previously established for the Summer Street Banner Art Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: City Council hereby confirms the selection of Katie Winkler as the artist for the Summer Street Banner Art Program and approves her proposed artwork, "Endless Adventure."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: That City staff is authorized to proceed with preparation and execution of an artist agreement for the project, provided that no artwork shall be installed or implemented until the agreement has been fully executed by all parties.
