**SUBJECT:** Approve Purchase Order 26-1701 to Motorola Solutions

#### DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:

Our current portable radios, the Motorola XTS 3000, have reached the end of their life cycle, and our WatchGuard body-worn cameras are in a similar situation. The Motorola XTS 3000 was produced in the mid-1990s to early 2000s, making these radios approximately 25 years old. While the WatchGuard body-worn cameras are not as old, they are no longer supported by the manufacturer, which means that necessary repairs or replacement parts are unavailable. Given that both of these critical pieces of law enforcement equipment are beginning to fail, securing funding to replace the portable radios and body-worn cameras in this budget year was essential. We successfully accomplished this within our budget by forgoing the purchase and outfitting of two new patrol vehicles.

To accommodate this purchase and the video storage needs, the City is also increasing its internet bandwidth at City Hall and transition to cloud storage rather than having on premise servers that are currently failing and would require replacement. This migration to cloud storage, which has an initial cost savings and will incur software licensing fees annually, which will be included in future budgets presented for approval beginning in FY 27.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommend City Council approve Purchase Order 26-1701 to Motorola Solutions for the purchase of Motorola N70 portable radios and Motorola SVX body camera and microphone sold as a packaged deal for \$144,026.21.
