RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF SANDPOINT

TITLE: AGREEMENT WITH SIMCO DEVELOPMENT GROUP, LLC, FOR LIFT STATION REPLACEMENTS (CITY AGREEMENT A24-3257-8)

WHEREAS: Two of the City's sanitary sewer lift stations, Beach Lift Station at City Beach, 54 years old, and the BP Exxon Lift Station on Superior Street between First Avenue and Iberian Way, 61 years old, are nearing the end of their useful life and require frequent maintenance, with the 2023 Collection System Evaluation Plan, accepted by City Council in 2021 under Resolution 21-037, recommending replacement of both lift stations due to their fair/poor condition;

WHEREAS: In addition to its aging condition, currently, the City Beach Lift station lacks capacity, where the reconstructed lift station will be designed to accommodate the anticipated increased capacity that will be necessary following the redevelopment of the existing hotel that adjoins the City Beach property;

WHEREAS: This project will encompass SCADA system installation by B&E Electric under the existing SCADA Upgrades Project, approved by City Council on March 20, 2024, under Resolution 24-014;

WHEREAS: This project was bid in accordance with Idaho Code § 67-2805(2), Category A, and City of Sandpoint procurement requirements, with the nine (9) bids received by the deadline publicly opened on August 29, 2024;

WHEREAS: Following evaluation of bids, it was determined that Simco Development Group, LLC, was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS: The project cost is within budget, funded by the City's Sewer Fund, with construction completed by summer of 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Agreement with Simco Development Group, LLC, for Lift Station Replacements (City Agreement A24-3257-8), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully incorporated herein, is hereby approved in the amount of \$1,213,700.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: As provided in the Procurement Process and Signature Authority Policy for Goods, Services, and Construction and further outlined in the City of Sandpoint Procurement Policy, on behalf of the City, the Mayor or authorized designee is authorized to execute the agreement as set forth above.
