**TITLE: AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR THE DIVISION AVENUE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT-PHASE 2 (CITY AGREEMENT A26-3170-6)**

WHEREAS: On April 1, 2026, City staff provided an update to the City Council regarding the Division Avenue Corridor Improvement Project – Phase 2;

WHEREAS: The Division Avenue Corridor Improvement Project – Phase 2 continues improvements from Superior Street to Pine Street, including installation of six (6) foot sidewalks, five (5) to six (6) foot planter strips for snow storage, curb and gutter, ADA-compliant curb ramps, narrowing of existing driveways, and the planting of street trees;

WHEREAS: The project was advertised and bid as Bid No. 26-3170-1 in accordance with Idaho Code § 67-2805;

WHEREAS: On April 21, 2026, one (1) sealed bid was received in accordance with Idaho Code § 67-2805(2);

WHEREAS: The lowest, responsible, and responsive bidder was determined to be Interstate Concrete & Asphalt Company, with a total bid amount of Three Hundred Fifty-One Thousand One Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$351,142.00);

WHEREAS: Construction of the project is anticipated to begin after the close of the school year, continue for approximately eight (8) weeks, and be completed by the end of July 2026, with a project deadline extended to August 31, 2026;

WHEREAS: Adjacent property owners have been notified and will continue to receive updates prior to and during construction;

WHEREAS: The project is funded in part through the 2024 Local Children Pedestrian Safety (CPS) Program administered by the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC), with grant funding in the amount of \$250,000, and the remaining balance of up to \$101,142 funded through Resort City Tax revenues for sidewalks; and

WHEREAS: The project has been budgeted in the City's Fiscal Year 2026 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: City Council hereby awards the construction contract for the Division Avenue Corridor Improvement Project – Phase 2 (City Agreement A26-3170-6) to Interstate Concrete & Asphalt Company in the total amount of \$351,142.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The Mayor or his designee, as permitted, is hereby authorized to sign any and all grant application documents for this purpose.
