**TITLE: AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A LEGISLATIVE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING (LSF) GRANT FROM THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (WW2604LSF)**

WHEREAS: The City of Sandpoint is advancing the reconstruction of its wastewater treatment plant to maintain regulatory compliance and ensure long-term system reliability;

WHEREAS: The project includes liquid treatment upgrades and supporting infrastructure necessary for continued effective operation of the wastewater system;

WHEREAS: As part of the overall project financing strategy, the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality has issued a Legislative Supplemental Funding (LSF) grant offer to the City in the amount of \$2,527,566;

WHEREAS: Such funding is authorized through Idaho House Bill 455 and is intended to support the construction of wastewater infrastructure improvements;

WHEREAS: The LSF grant is paired with the Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan and applies to the same Phase 1 project components;

WHEREAS: The LSF grant is provided at zero percent (0%) interest and requires no repayment, thereby reducing the amount of debt necessary to complete the project; and

WHEREAS: Acceptance of the grant requires compliance with Idaho Department of Environmental Quality requirements, including submission and approval of a project schedule, inclusion of supplemental specifications in bidding documents, authorization prior to construction contract award, adoption of a sewer use ordinance, provision of an approved operations and maintenance manual, and compliance with applicable federal and state laws including audit and reporting requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City Council hereby authorizes acceptance of the Legislative Supplemental Funding (LSF) grant from the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality in the amount of \$2,527,566 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Reconstruction Project (WW2604LSF).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: On behalf of the City, The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to accept and implement the grant in accordance with its terms and applicable requirements.
