**TITLE: AGREEMENT WITH INTERSTATE CONCRETE AND ASPHALT COMPANY FOR A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2025 PAVING MAINTENANCE PROJECT ON PINE STREET (AGREEMENT #A25-3100-2)**

WHEREAS: In 2020, the City engaged an independent specialist, Infrastructure Management Services (IMS), to produce a pavement condition assessment of all streets in Sandpoint, utilizing a van equipped with laser sensors to collect data every 100 feet, objectively measuring pavement cracking, texture, rutting, roughness, cross fall, crown, grade, and radius of curvature across all streets, with the findings helping to inform the City where, when, and how to invest in pavement maintenance;

WHEREAS: The 2025 Paving Maintenance Project, funded by Resort City Tax revenue, will take place on Pine Street, as recommended by the assessment, to include removal of existing deteriorated asphalt, repaving of Pine Street from Division Avenue to North Boyer Avenue, and pedestrian accessibility improvements, with the goal of improved safety and accessibility and maintenance of City infrastructure;

WHEREAS: The project was bid in accordance with Idaho Code § 67-2805(2), Category A, and City of Sandpoint procurement requirements, with bids opened on October 2, 2025, the deadline for receipt of bids;

WHEREAS: Following evaluation of the two bids received, it was determined that Interstate Concrete and Asphalt Co. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS: Completion is targeted for mid-November 2025, with construction proceeding as weather allows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Agreement with Interstate Concrete and Asphalt Company for a Construction Contract for the 2025 Paving Maintenance Project on Pine Street in the amount of \$287,596.00, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: On behalf of the City, the Mayor or authorized designee, as provided by the City's Procurement Process and Signature Authority Policy for Goods, Services, and Construction, as further outlined in the City of Sandpoint Procurement Policy, is authorized to sign the Agreement referenced herein.
