## SUMMARY

### INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Agenda Bill is to confirm the Mayor’s recommendation to appoint Kristina Hudson to the Economic Development Commission.

She has over 20 years of economic development experience at the state, county, and local level in business retention, expansion, and recruitment.
