



Stormwater & Urban Forestry Division Department of Corrections (DOC) Work Accomplishments May - September 2025

Department of Corrections: 6 Workdays in May:

- o Cleared **2 Storm Ponds (Raines and Swenson W4)** of excessive trees and vegetation to bring pond into compliance.
- o Weed whacked reed canary grass at **Three Forks Natural Area** to support the growth of 1500 trees planted for reforestation.

Department of Corrections: 11 Workdays in June:

- o Continued with clearing and chipping the **2 overgrown Storm Ponds (Raines and Swenson W4)** of trees and other vegetation.
- o Vegetation Clearance on **6 ponds for required maintenance**. Swenson Ponds E3, E4, E5, E6, E7, E8, Kinsey Pond and PPW Shop Pond.

Department of Corrections: 10 Workdays in July:

- o Finished chipping the cut trees and vegetation at Raines Pond
- o **Vegetation Clearance on 7 ponds for required maintenance.**
- o **Cleared trail to Canyon Springs** with Todd Shinn in Water Department.
- o **Fence repair at 3 ponds** (Raines and Swenson E8) and
- o **Fence repair along forest edge next to sidewalk on Frontier Ave SE.**

Department of Corrections: 9 Workdays in August:

- o **USFS Lot at Snoqualmie Point Park cleared vegetation** in parking lot and along trail leading to the trail head.
- o **Vegetation Clearance on 7 ponds for required maintenance.**
- o **Fence repair at 2 ponds** (Carmichael 1 and Hancock)

Department of Corrections: 7 Workdays in September:

- o **Vegetation Clearance on 6 ponds for required maintenance.**
- o **Fence repair at 1 Swale** (Isley 3 Swale).

Cost summary:

~860 hours of work (43x5-hour days for average crew size of 4) = \$4,504 (actual amount from invoices).

Cost per hour: **\$5.23**
