Subject: Comprehensive Plan – Transportation Element Policy Review

#### Background

The Washington Growth Management Act (GMA) requires King County and cities within King County to update their comprehensive plans on or before December 31, 2024. The transportation chapter (sometimes referred to as an “element”) is an essential piece of the Comprehensive Plan and must show how the City intends to provide a transportation system capable of providing for the updated growth targets over the planning horizon of 20 years. This chapter provides a summary of the existing transportation system and will address the long-term transportation needs and goals of the community. On October 2, 2023, staff/consultant presented a primer on transportation planning and the components of the Transportation chapter.

#### Analysis

On October 16, 2023, staff/consultant will present the first set of proposed updates to transportation policies to the planning commission on land use and transportation coordination, intergovernmental transportation planning, street system, bicycle and pedestrian system. The objective of the transportation policies review is to improve clarity in policy language, remove duplicative language, update terminology, and reflect recent changes to the Growth Management Act, and PSRC’s VISION 2050.
