Boards and Commissions:

- Community Development Committee reviewed the updated 2026 work plan for the CED Department.
- Planning Commission reviewed the Land Capacity Analysis for housing and potential zoning changes.
- Economic Development Commission discussed downtown activation of Falls Avenue.
- Arts Commission discussed the Art Off the Rails event and voted to cease participation moving forward. They reviewed the City Hall gallery artist submissions, 32 artists submitted applications.
- Parks and Events Commission discussed the purpose of the commission and will meet in August to further the discussion.

Planning Projects:

- A pre-application meeting was held on 7/2 to discuss a proposal to convert the main floor of 8084 Falls Ave SE into retail space.

Department News:

- Snoqualmie Proliance received a Certificate of Occupancy for a new location on Center Blvd.
- Northwest Badminton Academy received a Certificate of Occupancy for a new badminton club facility located in the Business Park.
- The Rec Room received a Certificate of Occupancy for a new community entertainment venue with food, drinks, and multi-sport simulators. The new business is located on Center Blvd.

Community Outreach and Events:

- Movies and Music in the Park: Two concerts, at Community Park amphitheater and three movies (3rd movie August 6) at Jeanne Hansen Park. The concerts were well attended by Snoqualmie residents and guests from around the Eastside. The turnout for the movies was less than expected due to weather (rain and smoke conditions).
- Blood Drive was held at the Fire Station July 23, 24, 27 and 28. This partnership is coordinated by the Community Liaison.
