SUMMARY

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this agenda bill is to authorize the increases of inmate housing with the South Correctional Entity (SCORE).

BACKGROUND

The City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with SCORE in 2012 for housing of inmates. The City received a notice from the South Correctional Entity that there would be an increase in their daily inmate bed rate.

BUDGET IMPACTS

2023 Booking fee increases from \$35 to \$50

2023 General Population – Guaranteed Beds increases from \$131.84 to \$138.43

2023 General Population – Non-guaranteed Beds increases from \$189.52 to \$199

PROPOSED ACTION

MOVE to approve the agreement with SCORE for inmate housing services from January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2023, and authorize the Mayor to sign.
