Issaquah Dispatch

- In January of 2003, the Cities of Snoqualmie and Issaquah entered into an ILA for Dispatch services.
- The contract was revised and renewed in 2014 to account for the addition of Snoqualmie's provision of police services to the City of North Bend.
- The contract was renewed again in 2019.
- The City of Issaquah seeks to continue our longstanding partnership with a new agreement accounting for the removal of North Bend.

Issaquah Dispatch Services



The Issaquah Police Department Dispatch Center serves as the Snoqualmie Police Department's Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), providing the following services:

- 911 emergency call handling
- Answering Snoqualmie non-emergency business calls
- Radio dispatch of Snoqualmie Police units
- Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD)
- Records Management System (RMS) including warrant entries/clearances/locates
