SUMMARY

Police Chief Perry Phipps resigned as Police Chief of the City of Snoqualmie effective July 3, 2023. The Mayor has chosen Captain Brian Lynch to serve as the Interim Police Chief until a plan to provide for a permanent replacement is made.

BACKGROUND

Captain Lynch has been with the Snoqualmie Police Department for one (1) year. He has advanced through the positions of police dispatcher, police officer, detective, sergeant, and captain during his twenty-seven (27) year law enforcement career. In addition, Captain Lynch holds the position of Commander of the Coalition of Small Cities Major Crimes Task Force where he supervises approximately 20 detectives on loan from 13 cities in King County. He is also a recent graduate of West Point Leadership for Law Enforcement.

The Mayor and staff request confirmation of this position as the City's Interim Police Chief.
