The City of Snoqualmie uses a competitive application process to allocate Human Services funds to non-profit organizations serving the Snoqualmie Valley. The Human Services Advisory Committee, a volunteer committee consisting of three appointed residents, works together with staff to administer the process and recommend funding allocations to the City Council. It is the Human Services Advisory Committee's goal to partner with and support local organizations that provide vital services to individuals and families in need. Organizations must meet the eligibility criteria below at the time of application to be considered for Human Services funding.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The funding request must align with at least one of the City's Funding Priorities:
 - o Food to Eat and a Roof Overhead
 - Supporting and Preparing Youth for Success
 - A Safe Haven from Violence and Abuse
 - Physical and Mental Wellness, and Healthy Aging
- The funds must be used to provide direct services to the community
- The organization must emphasize serving "at-risk" children, seniors, individuals, and/or families
- The organization must be recognized as an IRC 501(c)3 non-profit entity by the IRS or be registered with the State of Washington as a non-profit organization for Washington business license purposes, regardless of religious or fraternal affiliation; public entities qualifying under Section 170(c) of the IRS Code may also apply

- Proposed scope of work including a budget summary to be appended to the service agreement
- Proof of non-profit status (copy of IRS determination letter or State of Washington registration)
- Proof of insurance
- A copy of the organization's most recent financial statements
- A list of the organization's board of directors
