2. Community Center Presentation. Jeff Hamlin, Interim Parks & Public Works Director, provided a review of the Community Center Expansion project via PowerPoint presentation. Committee questions followed.
3. Director Reports.
 - a. Staffing update was provided indicating parks has one vacancy which they will wait until 2024 to fill, two vacancies in water and two vacancies in wastewater. All public works staff are trained to plow and the department is in a better place regarding staffing and CDL licenses. Vehicles are being outfitted, staged, and ready to go.
 - b. Project status update was provided noting Centennial Park is underway with concrete pouring on Monday and then playground facilities plan to be complete by Christmas. Other projects are

winding down. Sandy Cove is finished and under budget. Parkway is waiting for push buttons but otherwise finished. They will be starting the sidewalks project – 40 different sidewalk repours - and implementing a new program to start grinding.
