Per the staff memorandum dated September 18, 2025 and titled "Critical Areas Ordinance: Summary of Changes from Approved December 2, 2024" and the supplementary document titled "City of Snoqualmie Best Available Science Code Updates / Crosswalk," considered by the Planning Commission on October 6, 2025, the following is recommended to the City Council for approval:

- Amend SMC 19.12's verbiage and stipulations as detailed in the Crosswalk with the single exception of Crosswalk Item 18 [Code addition – 19.12.090(B).6], where the Commission recommends that single-family residences part of a previously approved development be allowed improvements with a maximum footprint of <u>500 square feet</u>, such as decks, patios, and appurtenances.
- 2. Particular attention is recommended for Crosswalk Item 21: Stream Buffer Widths (19.12.160.D). The Commission recommends the changes outlined that would increase riparian management zone (RMZ) widths from 75 ft to 200 ft for Class 2 streams, from 50 ft to 100 ft for Class 3 streams, from 25 ft to 100 ft for Class 4 streams, and clarification that Class 1 streams should be governed by Shoreline Regulations (SMC 19.08) with their existing RMZ width of 100 ft.

Recommended by the City of Snoqualmie Planning Commission on the 6th of October 2025.
