#### **RESOLUTION R2023-02**

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH JORDAN, UTAH, ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN (CEMP) FOR THE CITY OF SOUTH JORDAN.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Utah Code Annotated (U.C.A.) Section 53-2 entitled Emergency Management Act, and the Homeland Security Presidential Directive 5, all agencies, departments, and organizations have the responsibility to prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies or disasters with the primary objectives to save lives and protect public health and property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the threat that natural, technological, and manmade hazards pose to the residents and other stakeholders in the community and that those threats have been evaluated and analyzed regarding their potential impacts on the community; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CEMP is to develop a comprehensive emergency management program that will provide a system to mitigate the effects of an emergency or disaster, preserve life, respond during emergencies, provide necessary assistance, and establish a recovery system, in order to return the community to its normal state of affairs; and

WHEREAS, certain State and Federal disaster reimbursements require local jurisdictions to adopt and train in a CEMP, NIMS and Incident Command Systems (ICS) and certain Federal grant programs now require an adopted CEMP; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Manager, in coordination with other City staff has reviewed, revised, and updated the CEMP with all of its attachments and recommends adoption by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of South Jordan to adopt the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH JORDAN, UTAH:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Adoption. The CEMP attached hereto, along with all appendices and compendiums as periodically amended by the City Manager, are hereby adopted, to replace any and all other previously adopted emergency management plans.

**<u>SECTION 2.</u>** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
