## **ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 14**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH JORDAN, UTAH, FIXING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE SOUTH JORDAN CITY RECORDER.

WHEREAS, the South Jordan City Recorder is a statutory official; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code § 10-3-818 the compensation or compensation schedule for the City of South Jordan's (the "City") statutory officers is adopted by ordinance after a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the compensation for the South Jordan statutory officer, is the annual salary but does not include other compensation as described in South Jordan Municipal Code (SJMC) §2.20.120 C.; and

**WHEREAS**, the South Jordan City Council finds it in the best interest to fix the compensation for the South Jordan City Recorder.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH JORDAN, UTAH:

**SECTION 1.** City Recorder Compensation. The compensation for City of South Jordan elective and statutory officials is hereby set:
