## DISCUSSION

For the month of February 2024, the City of Sonora Public Works Department performed the following activities:

### Streets

- Spent several days pot-holing City Streets.
- Returned numerous shopping carts to businesses abandoned on City Streets.
- Spent numerous days picking up leaf piles throughout the city streets.
- Straightened numerous street signs around the city.
- Replaced a photocell for a streetlight on Sanguinetti Rd.
- Replaced downed stop signs at Macomber St, Arbona Circle Dr, and Williams Street.
- Performed Street closure, and traffic control for Tree Company for removal of a large Oak Tree on Barretta Street.
- Started annual roadside weed spraying around the city.
- Installed a directional sign for Caltrans at HYW 49 and Stockton Rd.
- Made repairs to an eroded section of Macomber Street.

### Facilities

- Installed two TV monitors in dispatch at the Police Department.
- Installed an assigned parking sign in the parking garage at the Police Department.
- Made repairs to desk in the City Historians office at City Hall.
- Load and haul unwanted tables and chairs from Council Chambers.
- Relocated a photocell for exterior lights at the Police Department.
- Made repairs to a damaged handrail on Sheppard Street.
- Pressure-washed sidewalks, and the upper deck at the Opera Hall.

### Parks/Landscapes/Parking Lots

- Monthly inspection of playground equipment at Rotary Park.
- Cleaned city lots with a blower weekly.
- Pruned shrubs and trees along Stewart Street behind the Fire Museum.
- Continue with weed spraying in City Parks and Landscapes.
- Removed a large amount of graffiti in the Terzich Parking Structure.

- Removal of graffiti in Rotary Park, and Coffill Park.
- Pressure-washed stairs to Coffill Park.
- Replaced damaged parking bumpers in the Famers Market lot.

### **Storm Drains**

- Spent numerous days digging, and flushing out storm drain inlets, ditches, and culverts.
- Repaired damaged storm DI grate on Lytton Street.

### **Cemeteries**

- Continued with annual weed spraying at Mountain Shadow.
- Daily-Check messages at Mountain Shadow, and return calls as needed.
- Daily Clean irrigation filters during irrigation season.
- Mark out plots as requested by the Funeral Home as needed.
- Set headstones as requested by the Funeral Home.
- Mowed, and edged lawns weekly during spring and summer months.

### **Miscellaneous**

- Daily unlock, and service of all public restrooms.
- Put up weekly event banners downtown.
- Garbage collection twice a week in all City parking lots, Landscapes, and Parks.
- Monthly fleet vehicle inspections.
- Twice weekly- Run Street sweeper early morning on a rotating street schedule throughout the city.
