DISCUSSION

For the month of April 2023, the City of Sonora Public Works Department performed the following activities:

Events

- Deployed changeable message boards for advance warning of pedestrians for the Home and Garden show at the Fairgrounds.
- Placed banners above Washington Street for upcoming events.

Streets

- Made repairs to sink hole on Stewart Street.
- Excavated and backfilled large sinkhole on Ponderosa Drive.
- Made repairs to eroded section of road on Bradford Street.
- Made repairs to damaged stop sign on Gold St @ Washington St.
- Spent several days potholing City Streets.
- Responded to big rig accident on Mono Way which required removal of large boulders from roadway.
- Loaded and hauled two truckloads of brush in City right of way by the Firewise Committee on Arbona circle.
- Started annual early morning roadside weed spraying.
- Installed 25 Chamber of Commerce banners on City streetlight poles.

Facilities

- Ran cat 6 cable in attic for internet connection at Sonora Police Department and mounted router.
- Made repairs to urinal at Opera Hall.
- Cleaned security camera lenses at Sonora Police Department.
- Installed window blinds in office space at Farmers Market facility.
- Ran cable for antenna from roof to office for scanner at Public Works.
- Serviced all Swamp coolers on City facilities.

Parks/Landscapes/Parking Lots

- Charged irrigation and checked all sprinklers at Rotary Park.
- Camera and cleared toilet drain in restroom at Rotary Park.
- Graffiti removal in Rotary Park ball field dugouts.
- Planted trees and shrubs in planters at the Terzich Parking Garage.
- Flushed plugged culverts on Dagoon Trail following flooding event.
- Inspected, repaired, and charged irrigations in all City Landscapes.
- Pressure wash stairs in the Terzich Parking Lot.
- Pruned and weed wacked the Columbia Way landscape island.

Storm Drains

- Fabricated new storm drain grate for inlet on Green Street.

Cemeteries

- Charged irrigation system and checked all valves and sprinklers for proper function for irrigating season.
- Patched roads at Mt Shadow following storm damage.
- Performed annual weed spraying at Mountain Shadow and Old City Cemetery.
- Daily-Check messages at Mountain Shadow and returned calls as needed.
- Daily-Cleaned irrigation filters during irrigation season.
- Marked out plots as requested by Funeral Home.
- Set headstones as requested by Funeral Home.
- Mowed and edged lawns weekly.
- Weed wacked around headstones as needed.

Miscellaneous

Burned accumulated brush pile on Southgate drive. Daily-unlock, and service all public restrooms. Garbage collection twice a week in all City parking lots, landscapes, and parks. Monthly fleet vehicle inspections. Twice weekly- Run street sweeper early morning on rotating street schedule throughout the City.
