

RESOLUTION NO. 02-05-2024-A

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON, AND THE CLOSURE OF, STATE ROUTE 49 (WASHINGTON STREET & STOCKTON ROAD) IN CONJUNCTION WITH CERTAIN CITY STREETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MOTHER LODE ROUND-UP PARADE, SATURDAY, MAY 11, 2024, AND OTHER PARKING RESTRICTIONS TO ACCOMMODATE THE RODEO TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY MAY 11, 2024, AND SUNDAY MAY 12, 2024.

WHEREAS, each year the City of Sonora hosts the Tuolumne County Sheriff's Posse Mother Lode Roundup; and

WHEREAS, The Sonora Police Department is responsible for the safety and security of event participants and spectators; and

WHEREAS, parking restrictions and street closures are necessary for such an event.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Sonora does hereby direct that the following streets be closed on Saturday, May 11, 2024, commencing at 9:30 am and shall remain closed until 1:00 pm unless opened earlier upon the authority of the Sonora Police Department.

1. State Route 49 (Washington Street) from Snell and Elkin Streets to State Route 49 (Stockton Road).
2. South Washington Street from State Route 49 (Stockton Road) to State Route 108.
3. State Route 49 (Stockton Road) from S. Green Street to S. Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following streets will be closed and no parking will be allowed on Saturday, May 11, 2024, commencing at 8:00 am and shall remain closed until 1:00 pm, unless opened earlier upon the authority of the Sonora Police Department:

1. Snell Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Bonanza Way.
4. School Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Snell Street.
5. Wyckoff Street between Snell Street and Washington Street.
6. The following streets between State Route 49 (Washington Street) and Stewart Street;
 - A) Elkin Street
 - B) East Dodge Street
 - C) East Jackson Street
 - D) East Bradford Ave.
 - E) East Linoberg Street
 - F) Theall Street
 - G) East Church Street
 - H) Gold Street
 - I) William Street
 - J) East Lytton Street
7. The following streets between State Route 49 (Washington Street) and Green Street;
 - A) West Dodge Street
 - B) Yaney Ave.

- C) West Jackson Street
- D) West Bradford Street

- 8. West Church Street between S. Washington Street and Green Street
- 9. June Street at S. Washington Street
- 10. Toby Street between S. Washington Street and McGowan Street
- 11. West Lytton and Bulwer Streets between Washington Street and Olive Street

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following streets will be closed and no parking will be allowed on Saturday, May 11, 2024, commencing at 7:30 am and shall remain closed until 1:00 pm, unless opened earlier upon the authority of the Sonora Police Department:

- 1. South Washington Street at SR 108
- 2. Restano Way

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that “NO PARKING” zones will be established on the following streets on Saturday, May 11, 2024, commencing at 5:00 am and shall remain “NO PARKING” zones until 1:00 pm, unless opened earlier upon the authority of the Sonora Police Department:

- 1. East and West sides of State Route 49 (Washington Street) from Elkin Street to Toby Street.
- 2. North and South sides of State Route 49 (Stockton Road), between S. Washington Street and 70 Stockton Road.
- 3. Stewart Street between Elkin Street and East Dodge Street.
- 4. North side of Lyons Street between Stewart Street and Shepherd Street.
- 5. South side of Lyons Street between Shepherd Street and Barretta Street.
- 6. Snell Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Bonanza Road.
- 7. School Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Snell Street.
- 8. Wyckoff Street between Snell Street and State Route 49 (Washington Street.)
- 9. The following streets between State Route 49 (Washington Street) and Stewart Street;
 - A) Elkin Street
 - B) East Dodge Street
 - C) East Jackson Street
 - D) East Bradford Street
 - E) Theall Street
 - F) East Church Street
 - G) Gold Street
 - H) William Street
 - I) East Lytton Street
- 10. The following streets between State Route 49 (Washington Street) and Green Street;
 - A) West Dodge Street
 - B) Yaney Ave.
 - C) West Jackson Street
 - D) West Bradford Street
 - E) Linoberg Street

11. West Church Street between S. Washington Street and June Street.
12. June Street between S. Washington Street and West Church Street.
13. Toby Street between S. Washington Street and McGowan Street.
14. West Lytton and Bulwer Streets between Washington Street and Olive Street.
15. Parking will be allowed for the “Official” Parade announcing trailers and designated support vehicles for those trailers which have been identified to the Police Department by the Posse.
16. The following parking lots:
 - A) The Sonora Fire Museum lot, located at 125 N. Washington Street.
 - B) The Sonora City Terzich Parking Structure, 1st level, located at 96 N. Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that “NO PARKING” zones will be established on the following streets commencing on Saturday, May 11, 2024, at 5:00 am, until Sunday, May 12, 2024, at 5:00 pm:

1. The south/east corner of the intersection of State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and Southgate Drive, in the area of the locomotive.
2. The east side of Solinsky Street between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and West Jackson Street.
3. Fairview Lane between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and the driveway into the Tuolumne County Superintendent of Schools Office.
4. Forest Road between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and the driveway into Sonora Regional Prompt Care.
5. The south/east corner of the intersection of State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and Southgate Drive, in the area of the locomotive.
6. The east side of Solinsky Street between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and West Jackson Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following parking lots will be designated as “DISABLED PERSONS PARKING” commencing on Saturday, May 11, 2024, at 5:00 am until 1:00 pm, unless opened earlier upon the authority of the Sonora Police Department:

1. The Terzich parking structure located on State Route 49 (Washington Street), second-level, front row, accessed off S. Green Street.
2. The Fountain parking lot located at the south/east corner of the intersection of S. Washington Street and East Church Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all vendors during the parade must possess a valid city permit for such activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sonora that all of the above is hereby approved, subject to the Tuolumne County Sheriff’s Posse meeting all liability insurance requirements as specified by the City of Sonora, and having met all conditions as required by the California Department of Transportation.
