

RESOLUTION No. 08-17-2026-A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE ROUTE 49 (WASHINGTON STREET) AND CERTAIN CITY STREETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE SONORA HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE, TO BE HELD ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2026.

WHEREAS, Sonora High School will be conducting the 2026 Homecoming Parade within the City limits of Sonora.

WHEREAS, traffic control and the closure of certain City streets will be needed to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, and parade participants during the event.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sonora, that all of the above is hereby approved, subject to Sonora Union High School meeting all liability insurance requirements as specified by the City of Sonora, plus meeting all conditions as required by the California Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following streets will be closed on Friday, September 25, 2026, between 2:30 PM and 3:30 PM.

1. Snell Street, from School Street to State Route 49 (Washington Street)
2. State Route 49 (Washington Street) from Snell Street to Stockton Road
3. State Route 49 (Stockton Road) from the intersection of Washington Street to S. Green Street
4. Dodge Street between Green Street and Stewart Street
5. Jackson Street between Green Street and Stewart Street
6. Bradford Street between Green Street and Stewart Street
7. Linoberg Street between Green Street and Washington Street
8. Theall Street between Washington Street and Stewart Street
9. Wyckoff Street between Snell Street and Washington Street
10. Green Street between Yaney Street and Bradford Street

School Street, between State Route 49 (Washington Street) and Snell Street, from approximately 1:15 PM to 2:45 PM.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED;

1. That no parking shall be allowed on Green Street, between Yaney Street and State Route 49 (Stockton Road), between 1:00 PM and 3:30 PM.
2. Traffic control is of a rolling roadblock type. Parade participants will not be allowed to stop in the roadway once the parade procession begins.
