#### **RESOLUTION 08-04-2025-A**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA APPROVING THE VACATION OF EXCESS RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED WITHIN APN 056-108-015

- WHEREAS, on February 6, 1995, the Sonora City Council accepted certain relinquished state highways as city streets from the California Transportation Commission (Resolution No. 2-6-95-B), including the real property identified as a portion of APN 056-108-015, as more particularly described and depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Right-of-Way Area"); and
- WHEREAS, the Right-of-Way Area is approximately 3,831 square feet (~0.088 acres); and
- **WHEREAS**, the City has received development applications to develop a multi-family and commercial project on a site adjacent to and including the Right-of-Way Area (the "Project"); and
- WHEREAS, the Project is located at 956 Oregon Street (APNs: 056-106-004 and 056-108-015) and involves the development of twelve (12) residential units and commercial spaces; and
- **WHEREAS,** on May 13, 2024, the Sonora Planning Commission approved the design review, site plan, and use permit for the Project, and recommended to the City Council approval of a rezoning for the Project; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City received three (3) appeal filings for the Project approved by the Planning Commission, for consideration and determination by City Council; and
- **WHEREAS,** on June 17, 2024, the City Council voted to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission, and introduced an ordinance to rezone the property; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Project applicant filed a vacation application with the City to acquire the Right-of-Way Area from the City, for purposes of developing the Project; and
- WHEREAS, on August 19, 2024, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the Right-of-Way Area as "exempt surplus land," pursuant to the California Surplus Land Act (at Gov. Code, § 54220 et seq.), as acknowledged by the California Department of Housing and Community Development in correspondence delivered to the City (dated October 1, 2024); and

- WHEREAS, the Right-of-Way Area abuts South Washington Street, a two-lane major collector running north-south through the City and connecting to State Route 108; and
- **WHEREAS,** on December 9, 2024, the Sonora Planning Commission evaluated the proposed vacation for conformance with the City's General Plan and forwarded its recommendation to the City Council; and
- **WHEREAS,** notice of this public hearing has been provided in accordance with the California Streets & Highways Code; and
- **WHEREAS,** City staff recommends that the City Council make the following findings for the proposed vacation:
  - 1. The Right-of-Way Area is excess right-of-way and is not necessary for present or prospective public use or traffic needs in the area.
  - 2. Vacation of the Right-of-Way Area conforms to the City's General Plan, as described in Planning Commission Resolution No. 05-13-2024-A. The findings of Planning Commission Resolution No. 05-13-2024-A are hereby incorporated by reference.
- **WHEREAS,** the proposed vacation is subject to the terms and conditions agreed to between the City and the Project applicant, approved by the City Council in conjunction with this Resolution; and
- WHEREAS, the roadway vacation is a component of the Project previously approved by the City Council, which has already been determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA Guidelines, § 15378); and
- **WHEREAS,** the purpose of this Resolution is to approve the vacation of the Right-of-Way Area described in **Exhibit A**.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the above recitals are true and correct and are made part of this Resolution.
- **2.** The Right-of-Way Area is hereby deemed excess and not required for current or future public use or traffic needs in the area.
- 3. The City Council hereby approves vacation of the Right-of-Way Area described in Exhibit A.
- **4.** Prior to recordation of the vacation, public utility easements shall be reserved along the vacated Right-of-Way Area, with the location and width of the easements as approved by the City Engineer and affected utility companies.
