Cases For discussion:

20-1025- On August 15, 2020, Donnie Earl Tourte, 51 of Sonora, was arrested for misdemeanor battery on a peace officer, resisting a peace officer and public intoxication. On the above mentioned date an officer responded to a report of a fight in a public place. Upon arrival the officer attempted to contact and detain Tourte who was attempting to leave the area. Witnesses informed the arriving officer that Tourte was involved in the altercation. Tourte then struck the officer and resisted while the officer was attempting to make a lawful arrest. Tourte was taken into custody and later booked at the Tuolumne County jail.

20-962- On August 12, 2020, Jeryl Dawn Schwartz, 67 of Meadow Vista, was arrested for felony battery on an elderly subject. Schwartz is the caretaker for a dependent elderly adult, who happens to be her mother. Both subjects were in town shopping for supplies before retreating to the mother's local vacation cabin. Schwartz became upset with the victim and struck her several times in a public parking lot which garnered a lot of attention from nearby witnesses. The injuries sustained by the victim required her to seek treatment at AHS.
