**SUBJECT:** Public Works Maintenance Building and Pickleball Court Project Updates

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## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive an Update on the Public Works Maintenance Building and Pickleball Court Projects.

## **BACKGROUND:**

### Public Works Building:

A new maintenance building is being proposed to be constructed at the City of Sonora Public Works shop yard at 111 W School Street to replace a building previously lost in a fire. The building will consist of a pre-engineered metal building that will have similar architectural features to the existing metal buildings.

The plans and technical specifications are currently at the 95% complete level. Dewberry has received revised comments and is currently addressing the comments and preparing the project contract document. This project will be ready to advertise for bids by March 10th.

### Pickleball Court:

A new Pickle Ball Court is proposed to be constructed at the Woodcreek Rotary Park at a location that was originally slated for a new half-court basketball court placed. Dewberry will provide the engineering services needed to prepare the design and construction documents (Plans and Specifications) for the Pickle Ball Court.

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## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

### Public Works Building:

The construction of the new building is being funded through a 200,000 Cal OES grant.

### Pickleball Court:

The construction of the pickleball court funding includes \$170,000 from a California Per Capita Bond
