AREA 1 REPORTS:

Violent Crimes:

- 1 – Felony Rape
- 1 – Felony Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Material
- 4 – Felony Domestic Violence (one with possession of a weapon on school campus; one with misdemeanor brandishing of a weapon and misdemeanor criminal threats)
- 1 – Felony Battery to Transportation Personnel
- 3 – Misdemeanor Domestic Battery (one including felony possession of controlled substance and misdemeanor child abuse)
- 2 – Misdemeanor Battery on School Campus
- 1 – Misdemeanor Sexual Battery (including misdemeanor contribution to the delinquency of a minor)
- 1 – Misdemeanor Criminal Threats
- 5 – Misdemeanor Violation of a Domestic Violence Restraining Order

Burglaries / Other Larceny:

- 1 – Felony Burglary (including felony conspiracy, felony prior theft, felony attempt escape, felony vandalism, and misdemeanor possession of a dirk or dagger)
- 2 – Misdemeanor Business Burglaries (Shoplifting)
- 3 – Theft of a Vehicle (one including local recovery by SPD)
- 2 – Misdemeanor Petty Theft from a residence location
- 1 – Misdemeanor Petty Theft by access card

- 4 – Felony Domestic Violence (one including felony assault with a deadly weapon, other than a firearm, felony damage to a wireless device, felony child abuse, misdemeanor violation of a domestic violence restraining order, and misdemeanor dissuade victim/witness from testifying; one including misdemeanor false imprisonment; one including felony rape and strangulation)
- 1 – Felony Child Abuse
- 1 – Felony Battery with Great Bodily Injury (including felony assault with a deadly weapon, other than a firearm)
- 1 – Felony Criminal Threats
- 1 – Felony Rape
- 3 – Misdemeanor Domestic Violence (one including misdemeanor criminal threats and misdemeanor assault)
