Cases For discussion:

<u>21-1021</u> - On 08-29-21, at about 1:15 pm, a resident on West Bradford Street arrived home and discovered 40-year-old Tracy Owens inside her residence. Owens was found helping herself to food and wearing clothing items she took from inside the home. The homeowner escorted Owens outside and called 9-1-1. Officers quickly located Owens in the immediate area and she was booked for felony residential burglary.

<u>21-1012</u>- On August 26, 2021 at about 1317 hours a fire, the Washington Fire, was reported just west of the city. By 1336 hours the fire had encroached into the city limits. The department took an all hands on deck approach and every available officer and volunteer was called to service. Dispatch was also staffed to handle the extreme call volume as well as dispatching duties. Officers conducted mandatory evacuations and later helped secure these areas from anyone. As of this report there were no reports of burglaries during the evacuation period. Multiple officers spent sixteen hours or more on duty to accomplish all the tasks associated with the fire. The cause and origin are being investigated by Cal Fire and have not been determined at this time.

Officer Shouse has graduated the FTO program and has been assigned to patrol. CSO Lemas is continuing in her field training program.

Contract/Reserve Officers:

Reserve Officer Danny Duffy has completed several shifts this month as well as responded to assist with the Washington Fire.
