Cases For discussion:

20-1321- On October 22, 2020, Joseph J. Quinn, 27, of Sonora, was arrested for felony battery. The victim, an adult sibling, and Quinn were at his residence drinking until they were both inebriated. A verbal altercation ensued, and the victim got into a vehicle and intentionally rammed a parked vehicle nearby. This enraged Quinn, who then dragged the victim from her vehicle and battered her, causing serious injury. The victim was subsequently charged with driving under the influence.

20-1284- On October 14, 44-year-old Jason C. Watkins of Sonora was arrested early this morning for possession of a stolen vehicle and an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. At 3:00 a.m on the morning in question, a Sonora Police Officer was conducting a patrol check of the Bank of America Parking in downtown Sonora when she spotted an occupied 2007 orange and red Toyota Corolla with a broken window and spray painted body parts. The Officer conducted a registration check on the vehicle and determined it was reported stolen out of Tuolumne County on October 7. The Officer conducted a high-risk stop and took Watkins into custody without incident. Watkins was the sole occupant of the vehicle and was booked for possession of a stolen vehicle and a local misdemeanor warrant for obstructing or delaying an officer.
