Case(s) for discussion:

Officers responded to reports of a residential burglary. Officers arrived to find the house had been vandalized. Officers left the residence after they completed their investigation. A short time later, Officers were called back to the residence for someone trying to gain entry once again. Officers arrived in the area and noticed a vehicle fleeing from the residence. Officers were able to catch up to the vehicle and conduct a traffic stop. Officers contacted the driver and conducted an investigation. When the investigation was completed, Officers arrested the driver for felony first-degree burglary, misdemeanor vandalism, and misdemeanor driving under the influence of alcohol.

Officers responded to reports of a large argument in the downtown area. Officers arrived on scene to see a large crowd in a downtown parking lot. As Officers approached the crowd, they noticed two subjects in a physical fight. Officers were able to get the subjects separated and conducted an investigation. When the investigation was complete, Officers arrested one of the subjects involved in the physical fight for misdemeanor drunk in public and misdemeanor battery on a person.
