

Area 2 Monthly Supervisor Report July 2026

Neighborhood Watch:

Case(s) for discussion:

- On 06/03/2026, officers were dispatched to reports of an assault with a baseball bat in the downtown area. Officers responded and located the victim, who informed them the suspect had fled on foot and provided a description. Officers checked the area and were able to locate the suspect and detain him. The suspect was later positively identified and placed under arrest. The suspect was booked into the Tuolumne County Jail for assault with a deadly weapon.
- On 05/01/2026, officers responded to reports of a physical altercation at a local hotel. When officers arrived, they located the victim, who had sustained minor injuries. The suspect had fled the area prior to the officers' arrival. Through their investigation, officers determined the suspect was on probation in a neighboring county and was wearing a GPS monitor. Using the monitor, officers located and detained the suspect. At the conclusion of the investigation, the suspect was placed under arrest and transported to the Tuolumne County Jail, where he was booked for felony domestic violence, felony burglary, felony probation violation, and misdemeanor vandalism.

K-9:

- The Sonora PD K-9 Handler has continued to utilize his partner for narcotics and has had positive results.
- The K-9 team is actively training twice a month and consistently showing progress.

Reserves/Volunteers/Explorers:

- Volunteers and Explorers have been holding meetings and trainings twice a month. We have gained new Volunteers and Explorers and continue to receive applications for the programs.

Recruitment:

- We are currently recruiting for a Records Technician, Dispatchers, and Police Officers.

Training:

- We have sent officers to multiple trainings over the past few months. Those trainings included Crimes against Children Investigation, Use of Force Investigation for Supervisors, Interview and Interrogation, and Introduction to Supervision.
