

RESOLUTION 07-06-2026-F

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA, ACCEPTING A FIVE-YEAR GRANT AWARD FROM THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) PROPOSITION 64 PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM (COHORT 4) AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$999,981; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AS THE SIGNING AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS; RECOGNIZE UNANTICIPATED REVENUES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/27 AND INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS BY THE SAME

WHEREAS, the Board of State and Community Corrections (“BSCC”) administers the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program to support local governments in addressing public health and public safety impacts associated with the legalization of adult-use cannabis; and

WHEREAS, the BSCC has awarded the City of Sonora a Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant in the amount of Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$999,981) for the grant period beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2031; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for eligible personnel, canine acquisition, training, equipment, vehicle outfitting, program administration, and other allowable costs necessary to implement the School K9 Officer Program in accordance with the grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to offer recruitment incentives to provide a more robust and flexible program to attract a highly qualified and diverse workforce.

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant does not require the City to provide any local matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that grant funds shall be used to supplement, and not supplant, existing local funds that would otherwise be made available for the activities funded under the grant, and that the City will comply with all applicable non-supplantation requirements contained in the grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, grant revenues and expenditures will be incorporated into the City’s Fiscal Year 2026/27 Budget and future annual budgets, as necessary, throughout the term of the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THE FOLLOWING SUPPORT OF THE BSCC PROPOSITION 64 PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM (COHORT 4) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Sonora hereby approves and adopts the resolution accepting the Board of State and Community Corrections Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program (Cohort 4) award in the amount of \$999,981.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Administrator, or the City Administrator’s designee, to execute the grant agreement with the Board of State and Community Corrections, and any amendments, certifications, assurances, reimbursement requests, reports, and all other documents necessary to accept, administer, and implement the grant, subject to approval as to form by the City

Attorney where required. The City Council further authorizes the City Administrator to execute the grant agreement on behalf of the City and agrees to the terms and conditions set forth therein, including all fiscal, reporting, audit, and record retention requirements applicable to the grant.

Section 3. The City Council certifies that grant funds awarded under the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program shall be used to supplement existing services and shall not supplant existing funding that would otherwise be available for the same purposes. The City shall comply with all non-supplantation requirements and other conditions of the grant agreement.

Section 4. The City Council hereby appropriates grant revenues and corresponding expenditures in the amount of \$999,981 into the Fiscal Year 2026-27 and future budgets, and authorizes the City Administrator to make any necessary budget adjustments to account for grant revenues and expenditures throughout the grant term, consistent with the approved grant agreement.

Section 5. The City Administrator and designated City staff are authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution and to ensure compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, grant requirements, and the terms and conditions of the BSCC Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program Grant Agreement.
