Enforcement of Keep Clear Zone for Sidewalk Access - 375 S. Shepherd Street

### RECOMMENDATION

Consider request from Gary Anderson to change a Keep Clear Zone to a No Parking Zone for better access to surrounding area.

### DISCUSSION

On June 13, 2022, Gary Anderson stated:

"As memory serves me this zone was established in the late eighties after the removal of a dirt sidewalk and several trees in front of the above address. At that time the City installed steps and access from the existing sidewalk coming from the north in front of 365 S. Shepherd Street. At the same time the City installed a block wall with a planter replacing the dirt sidewalk. This KEEP CLEAR zone serves a secondary purpose for our driveway directly across from the zone allowing us to take three plus cars off this narrow street. The zone allows us to swing over for a straight shot down our narrow driveway along with the need to back and park a pickup. It is only recently this access to the sidewalk and our vehicles has become an issue. The current resident at 375 S. Shepherd has increasingly parked in the zone. I believe Public Works has been by several times to freshen up the paint but were unable due to vehicles parked there."

City Engineer Gerard Fuccillo reviewed this matter in the field and recommends the City do whatever is necessary to enforce the presently marked clear zone as a no parking zone.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

No fiscal impact to the General Fund.
