24-278-On 03/24/2024, at approximately 4:30 pm, Sonora PD officers were dispatched to an assault. The victim of the assault stated he was asleep on a bench near the library when he was awoken by two suspect(s) kicking him in the head, back, and shoulders. The victim stated he was assaulted for several seconds before passing out. The victim regained consciousness and walked to the hospital, where he reported the incident to medical staff. A representative from AHS contacted Sonora PD and reported the incident. An investigation is being conducted, and the suspects are still outstanding.

24-267-On 03/20/2024, at approximately 0548 hours, Sonora PD officers were dispatched to a domestic battery. The victim stated she and her boyfriend were involved in a verbal argument. The argument escalated and resulted in the victim being choked and battered by her boyfriend. Sonora PD arrived on scene, but the suspect had fled. An investigation was conducted and a criminal complaint was sent to the Tuolumne County District Attorney's Office for felony domestic battery.
