One Percent Post Election Manuel Tall Report

March 5, 2024, Statewide Presidential Primary

The Tuolumne County 1% Post Election Manual Tall identified one discrepancy between the machine count and the manual tally, Election code 15360(e). It was determined that the vote was not caught in adjudication due the write in for the same candidate was not eliminated. The candidate's count was increased by 1.

Ballots in the vote by mail batches A 45 and A 10 were counted. All federal, state, and local measures were count. This batches included 133 and 176 ballots, respectively, and all races.

Ballots in vote center box A 03 were counted. All federal, state, and local measures were counted. This batch included 77 ballots and all races except for Green, American Independent and Peace and Freedom presidential races had votes.

All races were manually counted between the three batches.
