SUBJECT: Sonora Public Works Department Monthly Report for March 2024

RECOMMENDATION

Receive the Public Works Department Monthly Report for March 2024.

DISCUSSION

For the month of March 2024, the City of Sonora Public Works Department performed the following activities:

Streets

- Made repairs to handrails on Stewart St. and East Dodge St.
- Made repairs to the gravel road to the city gun range on Southgate Dr.
- Clearance pruned several sidewalks throughout the City.
- Repaired numerous stop signs throughout the city.
- Loaded and hauled several truckloads of downed brush from Southgate Dr.
- Loaded and disposed of two deceased deer from roadways.
- Made repairs to a trip hazard in the sidewalk at 68 S. Washington.
- Made repairs to Shandi-La Ln.
- Clearance pruned trees and vegetation on several Streets on the West side of town.
- Loaded and hauled two pay piles from City residents.
- Replaced several photocells on streetlights around the city.
- Weed trimmed several roadside locations on Mono Way and Sanguinetti Rd.
- Cleared mud and debris from sidewalks on Stockton Rd and Snell St.
- Spent several days pot-holing City Streets.
- Returned numerous shopping carts to businesses abandoned on City Streets.
- Spent numerous days picking up leaf piles throughout the city streets.
- Continued with weed spraying on City R.O.W.

Facilities

- Made repairs to the roof at the Public Works facility.
- Made repairs to the front doors at City Hall.
- Repaired kitchen sink faucet and replaced a door handle at the Police Department.
- Removed cabinets and lockers at the Police Department.
- Added shelving in storage cabinets for the City Historian.
- Installed several security signs in City Hall and Terzich parking structure.

Parks/Landscapes/Parking Lots

- Tested and made repairs to the irrigation system at Woods Creek Rotary Park.
- Removed three hazardous trees in the Dragoon Gulch parking lot on Alpine Dr.
- Camera sewer lines for the restrooms at Farmers Market.
- Repainted storage shed at Ballfield following graffiti tagging at Rotary Park.
- Monthly inspection of playground equipment at Rotary Park.
- Continued with weed spraying in City parks and landscapes.

Storm Drains

- Performed a drainage test by flooding Bradford Street.
- Modified the storms at Bradford St and Washinton St, and on Green St drain inlets to improve flow.
- Spent numerous days digging, and flushing out storm drain inlets, ditches, and culverts.
- Performed major clean out of the Snell St drainage ditch.
- Excavated and added drainage rock to the ditch on East Oakside St.

Cemeteries

- Tested and made repairs to the irrigation system at Mt Shadow Cemetery.
- Performed annual weed spraying at Mountain Shadow.
- Daily - check messages at Mountain Shadow, and return calls as needed.
- Daily - clean irrigation filters during irrigation season.
- Marked out plots as requested by the Funeral Home as needed.
- Set headstones as requested by the Funeral Home.
- Mow, and edge lawns weekly during spring and summer months.

Miscellaneous

- Daily unlock, and service of all public restrooms.
- Put up weekly event banners downtown.
- Garbage collection twice a week in all City parking lots, Landscapes, and Parks.
- Monthly fleet vehicle inspections.
- Twice weekly- Run Street sweeper early morning on a rotating street schedule throughout the city.
